


## Purpose: Why Christ's Church Exists

#### Ministry teams at GBC are planning their future using a professional approach. We are becoming more mature leaders and meeting needs more effectively.



MASTER PLANNING ARROW


#### GBC is aligning all ministries to a common vision. We all know where we are headed and we continually assess our ministries to maximize their contribution.


