

## CHURCH is aligning all ministries to a common vision. We all know where we are headed and we continually assess our ministries to maximize their contribution.



- Worship the Lord in Spirit & in Truth, together




Connect to Communities

It's what we do

**Note:** "Synergies" are benefits that occur when 2 things interact with each other that would not have occurred from either one alone. For example, in the above diagram:

By simultaneously <u>Developing Disciples</u> and <u>Serving with Strengths</u>, we obtain the synergy that

• Growth occurs best when principles are quickly applied on mission.

This benefit would not occur if we were <u>Developing Disciples</u> who were not <u>Serving with Strengths</u>, or we were <u>Serving with Strengths</u> but not <u>Developing Disciples</u>.
